ORDINANCE NO. 501

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WALLER, TEXAS ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE, 2015 EDITION, AS PUBLISHED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CODE COUNCIL INC.; ESTABLISHED ENERGY EFFICIENCY RELATED REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL RESIDENTIAL (OTHER THAN SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL), COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2000 FOR EACH VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 336 PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 14TH DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2005, TOGETHER WITH ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALLER, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The International Energy Code, 2015 Edition, as published by the International Code Council, Inc. (the "International Energy Conservation Code"), hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "code," is hereby adopted. A copy of said code is made a part hereof for all purposes, an authentic copy of which has been filed with the City Secretary and is available for public inspection.

Section 2. Future amendments (not including clarifications or technical notices of any type) of the International Energy Code, 2015 Edition, are not adopted by this article, and must be subsequently approved and adopted by the City Council of the City.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 336 passed and approved on the 14th day of November, 2005, together with all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4. Any person who intentionally, knowingly, recklessly, or with criminal negligence violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$2000.00. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court or competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Waller, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.
